BP projects in Alaska:

BPXA is involved in various projects in the Alaska region. It has a major focus on the renewal of their "North Slope" infrastructure. The renewal will include various components, including the installation of new pipelines, structures, and other related facilities such as highly specialized leak detection systems.

Specific "North Slope" focus for BP over the years includes the Prudhoe Bay oil field, located approximately 650 miles north of Anchorage, first discovered in 1968 with production commencing in 1977. This oil field is reported as the largest field in North America and 18th largest discovered in the world. It is estimated that more than ten billion barrels of oil have been produced from this region alone.

BP is also developing its "Liberty Oilfield" which will see drilling the world's longest horizontal wells in order to reach an offshore reservoir in the Beaufort Sea region. This will be a spectacular undertaking, with an estimated cost of 1.5 billion and recovery of approximately 100 million barrels of oil.

Significant other exploration also continues in the Alaska region, where BP is involved in various oil recovery techniques including horizontal drilling, and both gas and gas cap water injection methods. Other areas of potential development include pipelines for the provision of natural gas from the North Slope to North American regions.
