The Royal Malaysian Police commemorated their 201st anniversary on March 25th with a new motto 'Firm, Fair and Courteous' coupled with a new badge 'Integrity is Our Practice'. Currently the police force now has about 90,000 personnel which creates a ratio of 1 police officer to every 385 residents compared with the international police ratio of 1 to 250. It is reported that an additional 60,000 police personnel will be recruited over the next few years to ensure the effective monitoring of public order and prevention of crime.

In this regard, the police training colleges and academies, which play an important role in the new and continual development of personnel competency and skills, have also implemented the ISO Quality Management System to measure up with the competency needs of the force. The changes will involve infrastructure upgrades and expansion to enable enhancement in the quality of policing.
